Regulation of the Australian Fellowship of Seven Planes

Ordination Regulations

In accordance with section 18, paragraph 5, of the Constitution of the Australian Fellowship of Seven Planes (hereinafter referred to as "the Fellowship"), the Executive hereby declares that these Ordination Regulations operate as of [date].

Unless otherwise specified or inconsistent, the provisions of section 2 of the Constitution of the Fellowship apply in the interpretation of these Regulations.

1.

All persons seeking ordination by the Fellowship must complete an Application for Ordination as a Minister in the form currently approved by the Executive. Each application must be considered by the Executive prior to any ordination.

2.

An application for ordination may be refused by the Executive if it appears to them, after careful consideration of the application including any statement from the applicant that may be deemed necessary or appropriate, that ordination of the applicant would not be in the best interests of the Fellowship.

3.

Before ordination **all** applicants **must** undertake extensive Minister induction training set by The Church of Seven Planes Australia, or **provide evidence** of prior training or experience that is at least equal to that required by the The Church of Seven Planes Australia (bachelor in theology minimum).

4.

A person that is not already ordained by the Church may be ordained by the Fellowship provided it has been pre-arranged by the Executive for the person to be ordained into the Church by the Bishop or Archdeacon of the Fellowship at the same time, or soon after.

5.

Ordination shall be conducted by a ceremony, the procedure of which is to be set by the Executive and attached as an appendix to these Regulations.

6.

All Ministers of the Fellowship must, prior to ordination, sign such agreements or documents as the Executive may deem necessary from time-to-time, aimed at ensuring the confidentiality of confessions or other communication held between the Minister and any other person in confidence.
